



The Irish Accounting and Finance Association (IAFA) hosted an online doctoral seminar on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2023, titled "*Conducting a Systematic Literature Review in Accounting Research*". This event was kindly supported by CPA Ireland.

Our guest speaker for the event was Professor Kris Hardies, University of Antwerp, Belgium. Professor Hardies works at the Department of Accounting and Finance at the University of Antwerp and conducts research in accounting (mainly auditing), capital markets, gender, personality and individual differences, and social media.

Professor Hardies recently published a paper with co-authors titled "A Guide for Accounting Researchers to Conduct and Report Systematic Literature Reviews" published in Behavioural Research in Accounting.
