

Accessibility

When moving through the campus horizontally all routes are step free, with minimal ramps.

When moving around the building vertically each floor on the campus is fully serviced by lifts, including emergency evacuation lifts at key locations:

- BA (Birley Building): 2 stair cores in BA with 3 lifts
- BB: 1 stair core with lifts in BB leading from Level 2 up through the Fine Art studios
- **BC:** 8 stair cores in BC with 14 lifts throughout which include 5 emergency evacuation lifts in BC
- **BD:** 2 stair cores in BD with 4 lifts, 2 of which are emergency evacuation lifts

Induction Loops

Induction loops and infrared listening systems are installed throughout the Belfast campus. The induction loops create an electromagnetic field, which the receiver in a hearing aid picks up. It then converts the electromagnetic field to audible sound, delivered right to the ear of the person wearing the hearing aid. This helps to cut out background noise and hear communications as though they were being spoken up-close.

Toilets

Toilets and accessible facilities are located throughout the Belfast campus, usually in key areas beside main navigation points such as main entrances to each campus building and beside most stair and lift cores.

All accessible toilets have an emergency alarm pull-cord that relays back to reception.

Changing Places Toilets

The Changing Places Toilets available on the Belfast campus include a minimum of 12 square meters of space, a changing bench and hoist, height adjustable wash basins and centrally placed peninsular toilets with room at each side to support wheelchair users.

Car parking

Due to its **sustainable campus** emphasis, the University does not normally provide on-campus parking.

However, spaces are available for those with accessibility needs in the Frederick Street Car Park (see location here). Spaces should be requested when registering for the conference.
